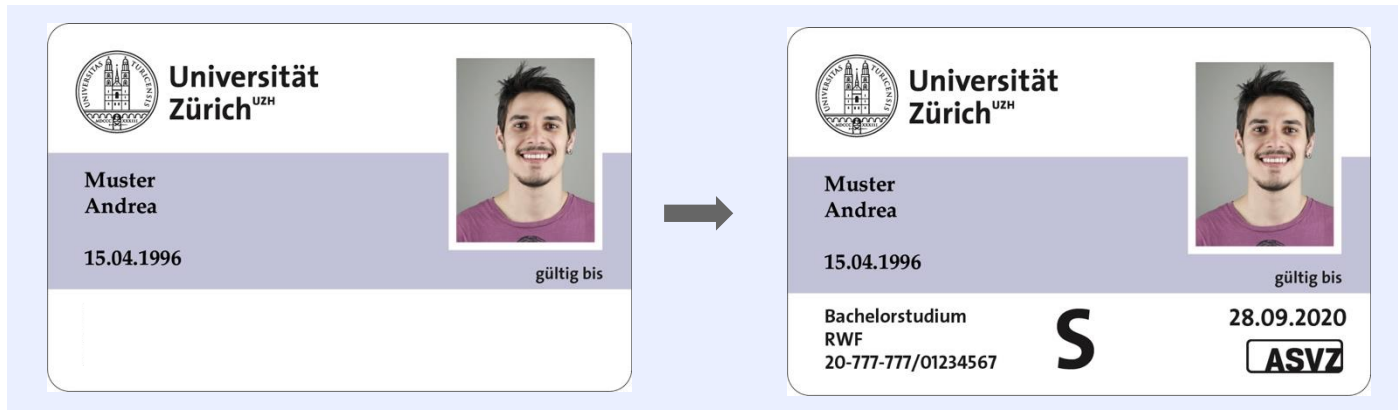

Health Insurance



It is **mandatory** to get sufficient health insurance coverage **within 3 months** of your arrival.

After registering at the *Personenmeldeamt* you will receive a letter stating the same from the health authorities. **Please keep this letter.**

- Students who have a European Health Insurance card can apply for an exemption.
- Students with a private health insurance or a state insurance, can apply for an exemption too but most likely the exemption will not be granted. Therefore, we recommend that you apply for a Swiss health insurance.

IMPORTANT: Students with a European Health Insurance card who plan on working during their stay cannot apply for an exemption and need to get a Swiss health insurance. As soon as you are employed in Switzerland, your EU health insurance can refuse to pay your claim.

Tip 1: Check out special flea markets “Velobörsen” in Kanton Zurich if you want to purchase a second-hand bike.

Tip 2: There are many free activities in Zurich: Join free walking tours in Zurich or enjoy free entry in some museums on Wednesdays. Nature lovers can explore the Succulent Plant Collection, Botanical Gardens, and Stadtgärtnerei – they make the hearts of plant lovers beat faster, free of charge.

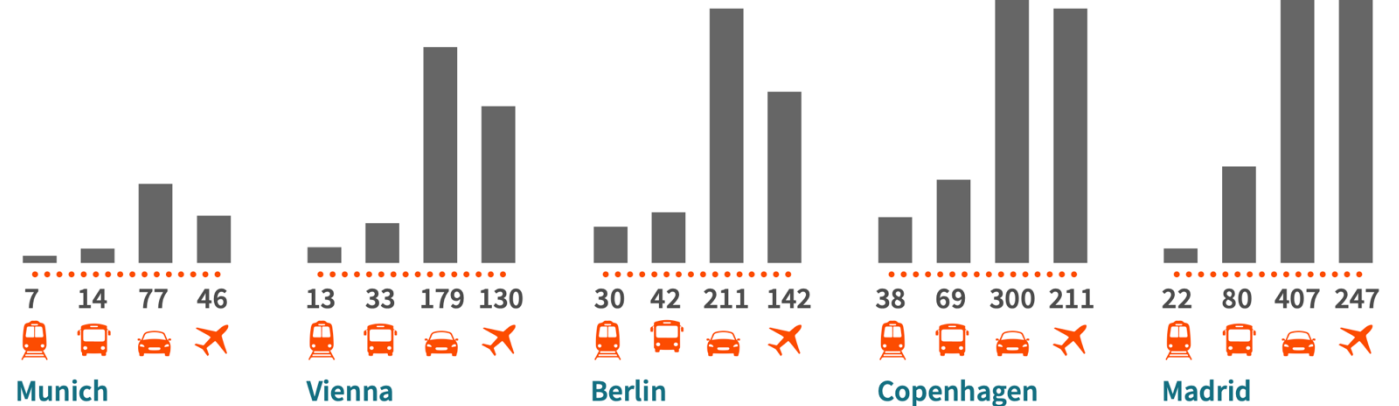

Tip: [Half-Fare Travelcard](#) (“Halbtax”) or [Saver Day Passes](#) often pay off quickly if you are travelling frequently around Zurich and within Switzerland.

Quality Doesn't Have to Be New

Buy preloved

Buying secondhand instead of new is one of the most impactful ways to reduce your carbon footprint. Are you planning to furnish your room, or looking for clothes, books or kitchenware? Make a difference by choosing items that are high-quality, secondhand, and affordable.

Tip 1: “Brockenhäuser“ (special secondhand shops) sell second-hand items, ranging from furniture and household appliances to clothes. You can also donate items that you no longer need.

Tip 2: Zurich offers regular flea markets, e.g., at the beautifully located Bürkliplatz.

Tip 3: There are many online Swiss secondhand platforms where you can get secondhand items – sometimes even for free – and sell the items you don't need anymore.

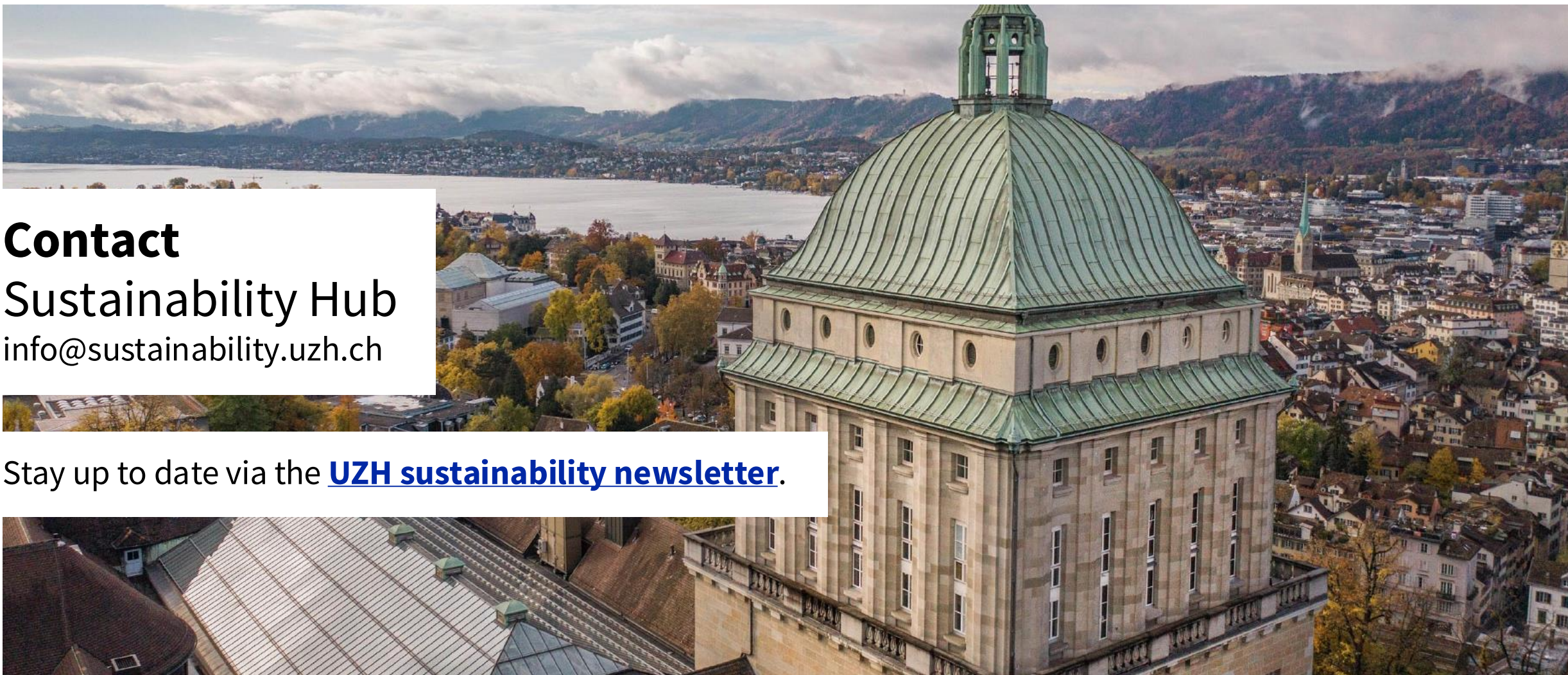

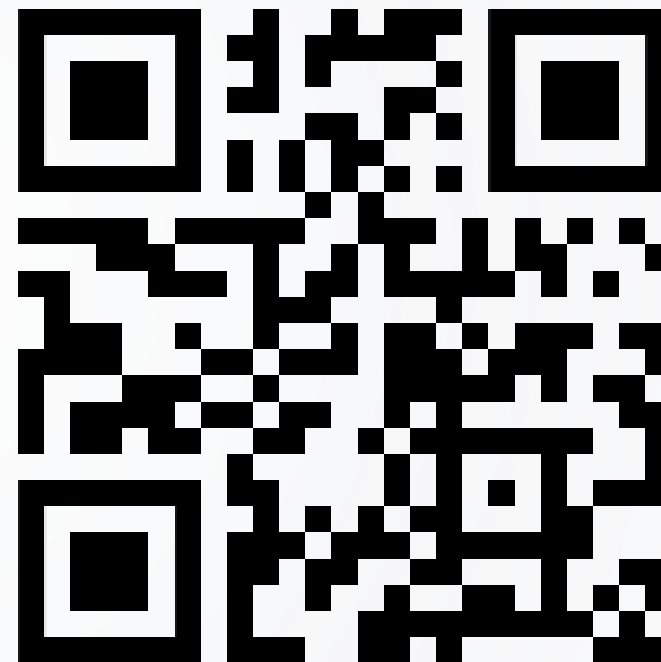
